- ➤ 1 large spool of matching thread
- ➤ matching drawstring 4 meters
- ➢ 1 stitch ripper
- ➢ 1 seam gauge
- ➢ 1 pair of sharp scissors
- $\sim$  1 package of stick pins with ball heads
- I extra large resealable plastic bag (e.g. Ziploc/IKEA)

- Section 3.5 meters of flannelette fabric (washing/drying fabric will help avoid shrinkage)
- ➤ 1 large spool of matching thread
- ➢ elastic 1 meter of 2.5 cm wide ~ non roll
- Solution >> 1 stitch ripper
- ➤ 1 seam gauge
- ➢ 1 pair of sharp scissors
- ➤ 1 package of stick pins with ball heads
- $\approx$  1 pincushion
- > 1 extra large resealable plastic bag (e.g. Ziploc)
