Year End Accomplishment

- Focused on teaching the eight core competencies (Critical Thinking, Character, Collaboration, Citizenship, Communication, Creativity, Literacy and being a Learner)
- Project based learning was continued through Genius Hour, Mitchell 2.0 Inquiry project, Creative Writing Units.
- Google Classroom and G-suite apps were used in most classrooms
- The Athletics Program was used to scaffold math learning
- Math teachers received PD or Refresh PD on the Numeracy Achievement Program
- Gr 5/6 participated in regularly scheduled Makerspace classes
- a designated Numeracy specialist supported Gr 5 and 6 students in targeted numeracy skill development
